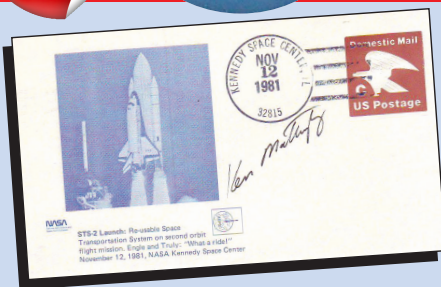

CON1038 Produced by Wedgwood, this is a commemorative Portland Jasper Blue plate. It measures 12.5cm in diameter with an outline of Concorde moulded on it. Retail packed with a protective sleeve in white with the Concorde logo embossed on it. Inside the box there is a certificate of Authenticity from Wedgwood with full explanation. This is a great collectors piece which was given only to passengers who flew on Concorde.

PRISTINE KEN MATTINGLY AUTOGRAPHED STS-2 COVER

SPA336 The rare autograph of **Ken Mattingly** signed on a 1981 STS-2 Space Shuttle launch FDC. Mattingly was scheduled to fly on the Apollo 13 mission but was famously held back due to exposure to German measles, which he never contracted. He went on to play an important part at mission control in bringing the crew back to earth. He then went on to fly on the Apollo 16 mission as Command Module Pilot and the STS-4, and STS-51-C shuttle missions. **£175**

JEAN BATTEN ON HER OWN HISTORIC AVIATOR FIRST DAY COVER

RAFVC740 Historic Aviator cover dedicated to and signed by the late **Jean Batten** (1909 - 1982). She was the first woman to be awarded the medal of the Federation Aeronautique Internationale, aviation's highest honour. This cover comes with a detailed biography inside.
